



Decisions published on CITC website

Most prominent violations published on CITC website



Activating, selling, promoting, or using prepaid phone cards in violation of the controls and instructions issued by CITC Board.



Announcing or applying rates or

promotional offers in violation to Rules and procedures issued by CITC Board



Damaging, interfering with, cutting off, or making illegal use of public telecommunications networks; disrupting communications; or preventing the exchange of information in general.



Failure to implement a decision issued by CITC against a violator. Decisions also include written notices sent by a CITC employee.



Using or possessing any telecommunications device not authorized to be used by CITC.



Failure to comply with transfer of number regulations issued by CITC
