

## Conditions and Rules of Usage of Domestic Power line Networks within Buildings and Private Complexes to Provide Broadband Services (BPL).

Broadband services may be provided in buildings and private complexes using domestic power line networks according to the following conditions rules and regulations:

1. Pledge that the domestic power network used is owned by the owner of the building or the private complex, and no part of the network owned by the public electricity companies shall be used, even if it is inside the private complex.
2. Abide by the rules and regulations issued by CITC in this regard and any additional rules or regulations CITC may issue in the future, and visit CITC website ([www.citc.gov.sa](http://www.citc.gov.sa)) frequently for any new rules and regulations related to this service.
3. Commit to use this technology inside the building or private complex only, and when connecting them together, to use networks and services of providers licensed by CITC only.
4. Undertake not to cause any spectrum interference or other negative effects to the basic services/usage or other services and to switch off the equipment whenever that happens, any time or anywhere , as CITC sees appropriate, without CITC taking any responsibility whatsoever for this stoppage.
5. Undertake to limit the provision of the broadband service to users of the building or private complex only, and not to provide the service to others for fees or for free.
6. Commit to use equipment of the right specifications as required by CITC and with right type approval and spectrum specifications approved by CITC.
7. Commit to any licensing requirements CITC may further issue in the future, including fees (if applicable).
8. Undertake not to impact the performance of the domestic electrical network, the service provided by such network or other services related to this network in any negative way.
9. Undertake not to use this technology in buildings or private complexes less than 500 meters away from sensitive buildings such as hospitals, government sites, military sites, airports and sea ports.
10. Commit to implement international safety standards.
11. Commit to the clauses of the undertaking of importation of the equipment signed to provide broadband service over power line.
